Confidential Information Overview

Some of the information reported by facilities on the Hazardous Substance Information Survey is confidential per ORS 453.332(4). Confidential information includes:

- Site specific: Exact amount of hazardous substances and storage location of hazardous substances.
- Emergency contact night phone number.
- *302 EHS Emergency Coordinator phone number and 24 hour phone number (new to survey in 2014).*
- Chemicals reported by a facility that have a hazard class code of 1.1, 1.2, 1.3, 1.4, 1.5, 1.6 (explosives); 2.3 (poison gases); 6.2 (etiologic materials); and 7.0 (radioactive materials).

Requests for Confidential Information

Requests for confidential information must be submitted on the CR2K Information Request form. Explain what the information will be used for. The request will be reviewed to determine if the information will be released. If approved, the information is for you only and cannot be shared.

Before receiving confidential information, you must enter into an agreement with our office that you:

- Acknowledge you understand what information is considered confidential.
- Agree to be bound by ORS 453.332(4).

"Site specific information regarding the exact amount and location of a hazardous substance provided to or obtained by the State Fire Marshal or by an agency identified in ORS 453.322 shall be treated by the State Fire Marshal or the agency as confidential."
- Agree that the confidential information provided to you will be used only for the purposes stated on your Information Request form and that it will not be shared with any other entities or members of the public.

Confidential information is not included in the public version of the Hazardous Substance Information System software, or in the Online Substance Searchable Database.
