






State Health Profile

- 70+ population health indicators
- Array: social context, disease outcomes, behaviors, healthcare access, disparities
- Available by Race/ ethnicity; CCO region





Traditional Public Health Data

- Vital Records: Birth, death, abortion
- Disease Reporting
 - Communicable diseases; Cancer
- Population-based surveys
 - Behavior Risk Factor Surveillance System
 - Oregon Healthy Teens
 - Perinatal Risk Assess Monitor System



Care Coordination/ Service Delivery

- Service receipt:
 - -Vaccines; C-care; HIV care; WIC
- Hospital discharge data
- All payer/ all claims data
- Electronic Health Records:
 - health information exchange



Newer sources of data

- Socio-economic indicators
- Economic:
 - -tobacco tax receipts,
 - Hospitalization/ health care costs
- Environmental:
 - density of fast food restaurants,
 - -side walks





Causes of Death & Premature Death, 2011




Behaviors that Kill Oregonians






Cigarette Smoking by Year, Oregon 1996 - 2011






Adults who Smoke by Age, Oregon 2011




Oregon Diabetes Prevalence




Binge Drinking in Adults by Age; Oregon, 2011





Alcohol-related deaths, by age group, Oregon, 2011




Specific Populations Race/ ethnicity Low SES



Mortality by Race/ Ethnicity


Years of Potential Life Lost Before Age 75 per 100,000, 2009**

OPHAT Overview

- Functions
 - Query major public health datasets
 - Calculate rates by county and demographic group
- Data (currently)
 - Vital stats (birth, death, abortion, linked infant birth/ death)
 - Communicable disease, incl HIV/STD/TB
 - Population estimates



OPHAT Future Plans

- New data
 - CCO-level Birth Risk Factor data
 - Behavioral Risk Factor Surveillance
 System (BRFSS) data

- New functions
 - Maps; Charts




OPHAT Access
