Oregon Health Authority Roles

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
- Provide teleconference services for all committee meetings (including caucus meetings if needed)
- Provide administrative support for CLHO committee meetings:
 - Reserve room space, if needed, at Portland State Office Building
 - o Take minutes/notes for committee meetings
 - Distribute subcommittee information to committee members before/after each meeting
- A PHD Lead is established for each committee for the following:
 - Coordinate internally within PHD on CLHO committee agenda items and issues
 - Provide guidance and support to PHD program staff in navigation of CLHO committee work and process
 - Coordinate with PHD administrative support for committee to assure appropriate coverage
 - Elevate CLHO committee issues that require systems level input or intervention to Danna Drum
- PHD programs may provide webinar resources for committee meetings as resources allow and appropriate for committee work

Best Practices for OHA and CLHO Committee Partnership

- While CLHO Committee members are local health officials, planning and decision making is proactive, transparent, shared, and effectively communicated, leading to coordinated and sustainable programs and capabilities across the public health system.
- PHD program managers and CLHO committee chairs communicate between meetings to discuss potential agenda items, anticipate problems and troubleshoot potential solutions, discuss future work that needs to be considered by the committee
- CLHO committee chair(s) and PHD Lead work together to develop and produce agenda
- CLHO Committees strive for consensus between Committee members and PHD staff
- PHD and LHD program participants provide subject matter expertise on specific topics, especially as it relates to program-specific strategy and implementation
- PHD Lead and LPH Administrators on CLHO committees provide a system-perspective on system impacts of program-specific strategy and implementation

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 On-going, open communication between Committee meetings between PHD Programs and Committee members will support greatest committee functioning,
