Collect and report population health data		<ul> <li>Administer BRFSS and Oregon Healthy Teens Surveys</li> <li>Report population health data in a format useful for LPHAs</li> <li>Identify and synthesize new data sources to address complex public health problems</li> </ul>
Collect and report public health accountability measures	Optional work to reduce gonorrhea rates and improve two year-old immunization rates, based on local need	<ul> <li>Collect and report public health accountability measures</li> <li>Submit all required reports to Legislative Fiscal Office</li> </ul>
Improve data system functionality to improve immunization rates**	Optional participation in regional immunization quality improvement meetings	<ul> <li>Improve interoperability of the ALERT database</li> <li>Update ALERT immunization forecaster tool</li> <li>Conduct regional immunization quality improvement meetings</li> <li>Update ALERT training materials</li> <li>Consolidate ALERT provider data to improve quality</li> </ul>
Implement regional communicable disease initiatives	<ul> <li>Implement a regional communicable disease control program focused on reducing communicable disease-related health disparities</li> <li>Participate in required trainings</li> </ul>	<ul> <li>Provide local public health authorities with technical assistance teams that include staff with expertise in their selected communicable disease area(s), public health system, and health equity</li> <li>Offer grantee meetings/training and strategy sharing</li> </ul>
Evaluate public health modernization initiatives	<ul> <li>Optional participation in evaluation planning</li> <li>Required participation in evaluation efforts</li> </ul>	<ul> <li>Contract for evaluation of local public health modernization initiatives</li> <li>Convene local public health and other stakeholders to develop evaluation plan</li> </ul>
