Completing the annual plan

- Choose a minimum of two different goals, and then choose one corresponding objective for each goal from the objectives drop-down list.
 - Feel free to develop your own objectives. If you want to choose more than one objective or develop your own, please type it in the appropriate box.
- Indicate your baseline status, either from the baseline data provided by the RH Program or from your own agency's internal data system.
- Describe the activities you will conduct to achieve your benchmark and explain how you plan to evaluate your objectives. We recommend that you monitor your progress periodically (e.g. every six months).

Please submit your agency's final report by September 1, 2017. The final report should be submitted using the same form. Our hope is to make the reporting process as simple as possible.
