## Foundational Capabilities/Programs – Inclusions/Exclusions FY18 LPHA Expenditure Data Collection

Step Two of the FY19 LPHA Expenditure Data Collection requires LPHAs to break out their total county general and other funds public health investment (minus exclusions) in the following categories:

- Communicable Disease Control
- Environmental Health
- Prevention & Health Promotion
- Access to Clinical Preventive Services
- Emergency Preparedness & Response
- Cross-cutting Strategic Development and Leadership
- Administrative and Other Indirect Costs

The table below can be used as a guide for determining how to assign costs among the various categories. The total amount for each category should be reported in the online line tool for Step #2. Once you complete Step #1 of online reporting, the email contact provided in Step #1 will receive a link to a second form that allows you to report the breakout across the program, capability, strategic development/leadership and administrative categories.

Whenever possible, expenditures should be reported in the first five categories. However, if there are cross-cutting expenditures related to foundational capabilities/programs that cannot be assigned to one of the first five categories, then either of the categories of Cross-Cutting Strategic Development & Leadership or Administrative & Indirect Costs should be used.

Expenditures should only be reported once in the tool.

The goal is to capture, to the extent possible, the true costs for each area, including direct and indirect costs.

Because this reporting requires programmatic as well as fiscal decisions about which categories to which assign costs, the LPH Administrator and Fiscal Staff are strongly encouraged to work together in completing the data collection tool.
