Regional STI/HIV Prevention Initiative Collaborative

Outreach & Testing

- 1. Conduct targeted outreach and engagement with marginalized populations and provide rapid HIV/STI testing in the field.
- 2. Educate broader public on trends and impact of HIV/STIs in the region.
- 3. Coordinate with Pharmacy and Referral/ Retention/Case Management Work Groups.

Clinical Pathways/Order Sets

- 1. Create a clinical pathway for common STIs that all clinics can incorporate into workflow.
- 2. Create clinical pathway tool for assessing for PrEP candidacy, managing PrEP and referring to PrEP providers.
- 3. Create protocol for self-testing for STIs.
- 4. Create clinical pathway tool for STI screening among pregnant patients.

Referral/ Retention/Case Management

- 1. Curate list of STI Champions in the region.
- 2. Establish protocol for linkage of all HIV Infected persons and PrEP patients to SHS ID Department and/or STI provider champions.
- 3. Establish protocol for referral and linkage of STI patients to other health and social services.

Pharmacy Working Group

- 1. Explore barriers to filling EPT prescriptions at pharmacies.
- 2. Prepare protocol for point of care to Rx delivery for EPT.
- 3. Apply to CCO for grant: collaborative care model using pharmacies as a point of care for testing and treatment for STI.
- 4. Propose pharmacy board action and legislative objectives and educate Pharmacies on FPT.
