

2019 County Health Rankings and Roadmaps Coalition of Local Health Officials Mini-Grants Application Process & Timeline

Background:

As part of the 2019 County Health Rankings and Roadmaps, CLHO will be granting **four mini-grants of \$1100** for local community events with local stakeholders and community members focused on turning equity assessments into action.

These four grants will be available for Oregon **local public health authorities** that have completed a health equity assessment and are planning on engaging local stakeholders and community members to provide input on the equity assessment and co-develop an action plan. LPHAs should ensure that engaging these stakeholders and community members will benefit the stakeholders and the communities they serve.

Local public health authorities interested in these grants will answer three questions:

- 1. Why should we fund your local public health authority to engage community members about the equity assessment and action plan?
- 2. How will the community members you engage benefit from participating in your event?
- 3. Briefly describe your plan for engaging stakeholders (identify which stakeholders) around the equity assessment.

Timeline:

- Application Deadline: March 1, 2019
- Notification of Mini-Grant Awards: March 11, 2019
- One-page final report and invoice (for mini-grant recipients) due: May 31, 2019
