## CLHO 2020-2021 Budget Presentation (To be approved in May)

CLHO presents the organization's budget in April each year. The budget is June 1 to May 31. The CLHO Budget Committee volunteers didn't meet, but Morgan had phone calls to solicit feedback from the committee. Katrina Rothenberger wasn't able to attend the April meeting to present the budget as the Treasurer. Morgan Cowling reviewed major changes. Documents were provided in CLHO Meeting materials.

**Dues:** These proposed dues would start June 1, 2020. There is no change in the formula. There continues to be a .0455 per capita assessment on top of a \$250 base dues. Changes are purely based on population fluctuations for counties.

In the CLHO Meeting materials there is a draft 2020-2021 budget. The first column is the current approved budget. The next is year to date expense (two months left). The 2021 column is the proposal put forward. Morgan called attention to dues and the OHA contract and reviewed fundraising for health equity training which will be spent in the next fiscal year. Expense highlighted include: personnel changes and benefits highlighted in a separate tab, and increased travel expenses.

The CLHO Board will need to vote to approve the budget in May.

### **Special Session Update**

Pat Luedtke asked for information about federal funding for local public health. AOC is tracking this more closely and thinks there will be additional funding for public health in a third package but Morgan Cowling has not seen if/how that will come through.



Morgan Cowling shared that Governor Brown released an Executive Order regarding supporting local government functions during the pandemic. Decisions regarding whether to hold a special session will be based on the May revenue forecast and how federal dollars are disbursed.

Pat Luedtke asked if CLHO is anticipating LPHAs to not be able to afford dues. Morgan Cowling said we started this conversation with the Budget Committee, and the first strategy is to make the dues affordable all the time. If there are LPHAs that think they can't afford the dues then we need to have a larger discussion about what that means. At this point no one has reported to Morgan Cowling that they would not be able to pay.
