Oregon Health Authority will be present to provide data and information as requested, serve as a resource on what is possible based on legislation and support implementation as needed.



# PHASE I

## Ambassador: Role & Expectations

### Criteria:

- Experience working in commercial tobacco prevention
- Systems change mindset to discuss, analyze and co-create a new approach for how funding statewide tobacco prevention decisions are made
- Liaison to respective groups (TRAC, CBO Advisors, CLHO, etc.) to ensure bi-directional feedback and alleviate pressure from Ambassador to represent all perspectives

### Expectations:

- Participate in 5 – 6 convenings between May and December 2023
- Develop initial model for shared governance, including identifying ways to increase capacity and readiness for the transition, plans for implementation, timeline and membership.

Compensation: Participants will receive \$1,500 to compensate for time, if eligible



## PHASE II

# Ambassador: Role & Expectations

### Expectations:

- Lead peer feedback process – review proposed governance model with colleagues, networks and others as needed to bring-in ideas and perspectives to revise and improve
- Participate in Ambassador convenings, ongoing communications, as needed, to finalize governance model
