I have attached grant budget materials related to the CLHO Emergency Preparedness agenda item for next week.

CLHO EPR Activity Summary:

- o The 2024-2028 PHEP NOFO Supplemental Resources guidance was received on 3/1/24.
- o The EPR budget subcommittee has met twice since 3/1 and the PE12 subcommittee met once.
- o Full EPR committee recommendations by quorum to carry forward to CLHO;
 - No funding formula changes
 - o PE12 changes that align with the new 5 yr CDC NOFO and reducing requirements.

Funding formula Recommendations

- o No funding formula changes are recommended.
 - Small base (population 10,000 or less): \$35,773
 - Large base: \$64,392
 - Distribute remainder by population
- o From FY19-FY23 (5 periods), the average annual LPHA unspent funds = \$226,657 and were redistributed

PE12 change recommendations summary (as time allows)

- Minor wording and nomenclature clarifications, clerical updates
- o Removes duplicative language
- o Removes the CDC PHEP capabilities self-assessment requirement
- o Removes Integrated Preparedness Plan requirement, which is duplicative to the workplan training and exercise plan
- o *Reduces* exercise requirements from 2 to 1 for all LPHAs. LPHAs counties with less than 10,000 are already at 1
- o *Consolidates* exercise and training requirements language, reducing and clarifying unnecessary language
- o Expands options for LPHA method to complete hazard risk assessment
- o Expands options for LPHA method to test 24/7/365 telephone availability
- o Reduces duplicative language related to utilizing Health Alert Network (HAN)
- o Reduces mid-year workplan review to an informal check in as requested
- o Eliminates the formal year-end review during year of triennial review
