Future HIV/STI Changes – Alison Goldstein, OHA Alison.Goldstei n@odhsoha.or egon.gov	<ul> <li>Overview of current HIV/STI program and proposed statewide service changes</li> <li>Alison presented the details of HIV/STI Statewide Services (HSSS) including: a review of the currently funded services, an overview of proposed changes, details of the new HSSS model, and plans for future CLHO-CD discussion.</li> <li>She also asked for volunteers for a workgroup to meet in the next two weeks and which would include LPH administrators and managers, CLHO-CD members and one of the co-chairs.</li> <li>Danna noted that this mix of managers and administrators is important because with changes in funding, that affects the overall budget for an LPHA, not just for a particular program. The perspectives from the program managers are important, alongside the input of the administrators accounting for their entire budget.</li> <li>Discussion/Questions:         Alison led the discussion and answered questions.     </li> <li>Several expressed gratitude to Alison for the work and effort it took to prepare this presentation, which was very comprehensive, thoughtful and equitable. Yes, HIV & STI epi information is a significant part of the formula and is required by our funders.

Are the rapid tests, such as the ones used in jails, part of the model?

Testing is included as a core activity. The LPHA needs to be able to refer people, make it available in their county (through a clinical setting, etc.) or provide testing directly, including, but not limited to, rapid testing.
