TB Data Collection Updates	Heidi Behm	CHLO CD previously provided feedback to Heidi on the TB Data Collection Form. The purpose of additional data collection is to build capacity for LTBI being reportable. Heidi states local staff will see additional data elements for TB cases and eventually LTBI cases. Heidi stated LTBI will remain unreportable in Oregon and it was agreed Oregon would not collect citizenship information.	OHA will look up the Occupational Codes for local staff.
TB Funding Formula	Heidi Behm and Annick Benson	Annick reviewed the proposed 2018 funding formula, OHA would continue to provide testing services, medications, reimbursement for chest x-rays and incentives for patients. Annick also reviewed the special needs funding which can be used to cover increased costs for outbreaks or complicated cases. She added the TB program element will continue to be a part of the contract between OHA and local departments. Heidi stated that every county has had a B waiver case; payment will be based on notification of the case to the local health department. Most of the members on the call were in favor of	Motion to approve the TB funding formula by Katrina Rothenberger, second by Amy Manchester-Harris. Motion carried.

Animal Bites	Jackson Baures, Paul Cieslak	Jackson started the conversation by saying there have been some questions about animal bites during recent Triennial Reviews. Paul stated the Module in Orpheus on animal bites is important for data collection. Local staff is required to document any animal bite when there is a concern for human rabies. Emilio talked about lab services, for local staff the default is to send specimens to OSPHL. He asked that local staff reserve OSU lab for situations such as an owner is bit by own animal, or animal to animal bites. Local counties (or owner) must pay for testing at OSU lab. Local staff can use Orpheus for tracking suspect rabies cases. Paul added the timeline for the release of a new Triennial Tool that includes animal bites is still uncertain.	
Legislative Policy Statements	Morgan Cowling	Morgan is asking for volunteers to write legislative policy statements on issues of CD significance. This effort is in line with accreditation and modernization efforts. CHLO will use the policy statements when talking/meeting with legislators.	Members can review existing policy statements on the CHLO website. This item will be placed on the July agenda, drafts need to be completed in August.
