Are there clear ways to define what the county does and what the Alliance does.  Renee: HIV Alliance started from a collaborative approach with the counties. We provide case management and peer services to some counties and try to coordinate with counties on not duplicating services. We want cover as much of the state as we can. Each county's needs are different, so there is what they do, what we offer and what other partners can provide as well.</li> <li>● When working with a county that needs a specific subcontractor for a certain population or service, how does being a "jack of all trades" play out?</li> </ul>			
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	<p>Renee: We stay within the scope of our mission and avoid work that doesn't align, though the mission can be interpreted broadly. Being a regional organization adds complexity, because each county health department has different priorities, communities, and leadership perspectives. That means we have to adapt and collaborate with partners, while staying grounded in our mission, which is challenging.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>You offer some dental services broadly throughout the state. How does that work for a remote region you don't often work in? Renee: They would reach out to our dental case manager or call the main line. I can provide a specific contact. It is also listed on the Ryan White staff list.</li> <li>Would you travel to that area for that service, or would they have to go to somewhere like Eugene. Renee: Yes, we travel for people living with HIV. And it is more financial assistance based. If someone for example is a Ryan White case, it is more about financial navigation, not actual delivery of care.</li> </ul>
