The Public Health Law Center (PHLC) is a nationally recognized nonprofit based in Minnesota that supports public health professionals in advancing evidence-based policy across several key areas, including Commercial Tobacco Control, Healthy Eating & Active Living, and Climate Justice.

Through a Cooperative Agreement with the CDC's National Center for State, Tribal, Local, and Territorial Public Health Infrastructure and Workforce, PHLC now offers free legal technical assistance, trainings, and publications to local and state health departments.

PHLC's support also covers critical issues such as:

- Public health data sharing and privacy
- Legal considerations around preemption
- Public health authority and governance
