	Timeline	and Education Program (TPEP) 2023-2025 Request for Applications (RFA). Steven confirmed that proposed changes to award ranges and program/policy requirements (that were approved by CLHO HPP via an online survey) were incorporated into the final RFA. Steven also confirmed that 90-day bridge funding would be available from July 1, 2023, through September 30, 2023, to allow local TPEP programs more time to respond to the RFA and for HPCDP to review and approve applications. Several committee members thanked the state for the most collaborative program funding mechanism in recent history. The counties are pleased with the changes and look forward to building relationships in the future.
