2016 Legislative Session Bill Tracking Summary

Current Bills Tracked: 7

Active Issues:

- 1. Tobacco Retail Licensure: SB 1559B Passed Ways and Means Committee, scheduled for vote in the Senate (3/2)
- 2. Marijuana: HB 4014A Passed in the House and Senate (2/24), goes to Governor for signature.

Current Legislation Tracked:

Tobacco

- HB 4062 Establishes tax on retail sales of E-Cigs, requires retailers to register with Dept. of Revenue.
- HB 4103 Establishes \$1,000 fee for smoke shop certification, renewal and relocation. Those certified under current criteria must renew certification every five years.
- SB 1559B Requires retailers to be licensed by Dept. of Revenue and specifies that cities and counties may not adopt other types of ordinance related to retailers (preemption).

Marijuana

- HB 4014A Modifies laws regulating production, processing, sale, use and governance of cannabis. Includes youth prevention program.
- SB 1511 Allows the sale of medical marijuana products at licensed recreational marijuana outlets.



SB 1598A - Exempts certain applicants for license to produce marijuana from landu use compatibility statement requirement and modifies laws related to county and city regulation of marijuana business entities. Provides for expungement of some marijuana-related crimes.

Transportation

SB 1521 – Authorizes municipal transit agencies to levy taxes for mass transit districts.
