What is the Oregon BRFSS?

WHAT? A survey, conducted by phone

WHERE? Oregon

WHO? Adults in residential households

WHEN? Annually since 1988, cell phone since 2010

WHY?
Learn about health status, health behaviors, preventive health practices, and health care access





What is Oregon County BRFSS?

- ✓ Four years of Oregon BRFSS data combined.
- ✓ Not all questions are analyzable at county level. Only questions with enough respondents, for 20 or more counties, are retained.
- ✓ Information is adjusted to the demographic characteristics of each Oregon county

Who created the County BRFSS?

- The Health Promotion and Chronic Disease Prevention section (HPCDP) of Oregon Public Health Division created the dataset
- Staff reviewed how many individuals in each county had answered each survey question. If 20 or more counties had 50 or more respondents, the question was included in the final dataset.
- A final dataset was created that included only survey questions with sufficient county numbers and demographic information.
- The final dataset was cleaned and adjusted to the demographic characteristics of each county.



Why was the County BRFSS created?

- With the County BRFSS, can calculate county-level prevalence for:
 - Cigarettes smoking
 - Chronic diseases
 - Colorectal cancer screening
 - Heavy and binge drinking
 - High blood pressure
 - High cholesterol
 - Obesity
 - Many others









Preliminary results: current cigarette smoking

 - The method for adjusting to counties' demographics has changed
