Decision Making Framework

<b>Criterion</b>	<b>Definition</b>	<b>Ranking (1-4)</b> <i>1=Strongly disagree; 4=Strongly agree</i>
Clinical relevance	Measure is clinically relevant for populations (adolescents, youth) served by SBHCs and for clinics/providers	
CQI	Measure tracking and auditing supports continuous clinical quality improvement.	
Ease to obtain	Measure is able to be relatively easily obtained from EHR systems (via existing reports, etc.)	
Prevention	Measure emphasizes disease prevention and/or health promotion.	
Utilization	Measure is utilized by other entities (e.g., CHIPRA, Oregon PCPCH Program, etc.) to assess quality of care and support clinical practice improvement.	
Valid	Measure is evidence-based and able to validly capture intended metric	
Feasible	Measure is able to be impacted within timeframe of service provision
