# Draft Survey to Collect Feedback on the Needs for the Local Public Health Modernization Implementation Plan (MIP)

Oregon Statute (ORS 431.143) outlines the following regarding the local public health modernization plan each LPHA is required to submit to the Oregon Health Authority by December, 2025:

Each local public health authority shall [...]:

In consideration of the local public health modernization assessment, adopt, implement, monitor, evaluate and modify as necessary a local public health modernization plan that includes:

A plan for <u>applying the foundational capabilities</u> established under <u>ORS 431.131</u> (...) and <u>implementing the foundational programs</u> established under <u>ORS 431.141 (...)</u> as required by <u>ORS 431.417 (...)</u>; and

Any other local public health program or activity that the local public health authority considers necessary to protect the public health and safety [...]

The CLHO Systems and Innovation Committee is working to develop guidance and/or tools to help LPHAs develop this Plan per ORS 431.143. The Committee is referring to this Plan as the LPHA Modernization Implementation Plan (MIP). In this survey, we are seeking input from LPHAs on the types of guidance and/or tools that would be most useful in helping to complete the LPHA MIP.





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

### Section 1: Has Your LPHA Begun Working on a Modernization Plan








Section 2: How Does Your LPHA Envision the MIP Complementing Existing Plans or Efforts








